

# RECYCLING GUIDE FROM AVFALLSSERVICE AS

Remember to tie the bags tightly! The bags can be found in stores

## Food waste - organic waste



- leftover food without packaging; bread, meat, fish, vegetables etc.
- household paper/napkins
- flowers
- coffee filter and coffee grounds
- shells (from eggs, vegetable peels, shellfish etc.)
- teabags and tea leaves
- other compostable waste
- **NO** glass, cans, tubes, etc., even if they contain food leftovers

## Paper, cardboard and carton



- egg cartons
- pizza boxes
- cartons for detergent and rinse aid (refill)
- other packaging such as sugar boxes, boxes of peas and similar packaging
- shoe boxes
- newspapers
- magazines
- advertisement (without product samples or plastic packaging)
- printer paper
- envelopes
- milk carton, juice boxes, and other drink cartons
- cartons for pudding, jelly, sauce etc.
- yoghurt carton
- cartons for tomatoes, corn, and other similar cartons

**Remember to rinse and dry the cartons**

## Plastemballasje



- plastic wrap
- plastic bags
- plastic bottles
- plastic jugs
- plastic cups
- plastic boxes
- plastic packaging from food good, such as from coffee, toppings, potato chips etc.
- **NO** toys made from plastic
- **NO** toothbrushes and similar plastic objects

Rinse and dry the packaging

## Residual waste



Residual waste is everything that is not placed in the colored bags. Use white bags or inverted shopping bags

- Packaging paper/wrapping paper
- Dirty paper and dirty plastic
- diapers, sanitary napkins and similar items
- clothing and textiles
- twine
- solid colored paper
- plastic objects (not packaging; see purple bag) f.eks. toys, pens, toothbrushes etc.
- cat litter
- ash and charcoal, use double bags
- bones

## Hazardous waste

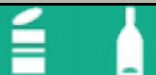


### Deliver to recycling station

Should not be mixed with other waste

- fluorescent lights, energy saving bulbs etc
- paint, varnish, glue, solvents, oils and other chemical products
- all types of batteries
- electronics

## Glass and metal



Glass and metal packaging must be delivered to their own containers.

**Kitchen glasses, cups and plates is residual waste.**
